Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) acknowledged the outcomes of the 7th Dialogue on Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) held at this session¹ and expressed its gratitude to Parties, admitted observer organizations and other stakeholders for sharing experiences and exchanging ideas, good practices and lessons learned to advance the discussions on the review of the Doha work programme on Article 6 of the Convention and ways of enhancing the implementation of education, training, public awareness, public participation, public access to information, and international and regional cooperation so as to also enhance actions under Article 12 of the Paris Agreement.
- 2. The SBI recommended a draft decision on the terms of reference for the review of the Doha work programme for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-fifth session (December 2019) (for the text of the draft decision, see document FCCC/SBI/2019/L.3/Add.1).
