SECTION 1: REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ)

Dear Sir / Madam,

Centre for Environment Education (CEE) kindly requests your quotation for the scope of work detailed in **Annexure 1 of this RFQ**, for supply, installation, training and commissioning of recycling machinery at the **Material Recycling Centre (MRC), Ujjain**. This Request for Quotation comprises the following documents:

- Section 1: This request letter.
- Section 2: RFQ Instructions and Data.
- Annexure 1: Schedule of Requirements.
- Annexure 2: Quotation Submission Form.
- Annexure 3: Technical and Financial Offer.
- Annexure 4: Forms for release of payments.

When preparing your quotation, please be guided by the **RFQ Instructions and Data**. Please note that quotations must be submitted **only using Annexure 2**:

Quotation Submission Form and Annexure 3: Technical and Financial Offer, by the method and by the date and time indicated in **Section 2. Can be password protected.**

It is your responsibility to ensure that your quotation is submitted on or before the deadline. Quotations received after the submission deadline, for whatever reason, **will not be considered for evaluation.**

Thank you and we look forward to receiving your quotations. The bidder should submit the bids on or before **27 September 2026 by 6 PM.**

SECTION 2: RFQ INSTRUCTIONS AND DATA

Introduction

Material Recycling Centres (MRCs) are defined as “Integrated Material Recycling Centres” for recycling thin plastic waste, rigid plastics and multi-layered plastics (MLP), which are collected, segregated and shredded at material recovery facilities with support from City Municipal Corporations (CMCs) or equivalent, and by Waste Pickers (Safai Mitras) and Service Providers (SPs), in every city. The centre enables recycling of **PP/PE/LDPE/HDPE/LLDPE and adds product value**, increasing incomes for Safai Mitras.

At MRCs, shredded plastic waste is washed using washing lines and dried using a dryer machine. The cleaned plastic flakes are agglomerated in an agglomeration machine to increase density, and then fed into an extrusion machine to produce pellets or other materials.

A. Scope of Work

CEE, in partnership with Ujjain Zilla Panchayat and HDFC Bank, is establishing a Material Recycling Centre (MRC) of 9,000 sq. ft. at Ujjain and installing machines for recycling of plastic waste. There is a requirement for Supply, Installation, Training and Commissioning of the following machines at the MRC:

- **Lot 1: Double Stage Recycling Extruder with Strand Pelletizer**
- **Lot 2: Agglomeration Machine**
- **Lot 3: Automatic Grinding, Washing and Drying Line with Accessories**

The technical specifications of each machine are attached herewith in Annexure 1. **The bidder has to provide a warranty on all parts of the machines supplied at MRC for a minimum of 1 (one) year from the date of installation, commissioning and training on the machine.**

Note: Supply of machines includes the cost of packing, loading, unloading, transit insurance and transportation of the machines to the MRC site at **Ujjain MRC Site**. The bid should also be inclusive of all starters, motors and panel boards etc duly verified.

B. Bidder's Qualification

- Bidder should have at least 3 years' experience in manufacturing and supplying plastic waste recycling machines.
- Bidder should have done a minimum average of Rs. 5 Crore worth of works in the last 3 (three) financial years.
- Bidder should submit supply orders / completion certificates with contract details from a minimum of 3 (three) parties in the last financial year.

C. Documents to be Submitted

Bidders shall include the following documents in their quotation:

- Technical and Financial Offer duly completed and signed, in accordance with the Schedule of Requirements in Annexure 1 (Annexure 3).
- Company Profile.
- Company Registration Certificate and GST Registration Certificate.
- Company PAN copy.

- Descriptive literature: full technical details of the products being offered, including technical data sheets and photographs showing general and detail views. Specific details of items offered should be clearly stated, as standard catalogues may offer multiple options.
- **Machine specifications with photographs of a similar machine supplied previously.**
- Documents evidencing supply of similar machinery to private/public sector/government organisations — copies of a minimum of 3 purchase orders or contracts.
- Statement of satisfactory performance certificates from the top 3 clients by contract value in a similar field, with client contact details for reference checks.
- Audited financial statements / turnover certificate supporting the minimum average annual works value stated in Section B.
- The bid should be given on Company Letter Head.
- **The Company GST number should be mentioned.**
- **The bid should be signed and duly stamped.**
- **All applicable taxes should be mentioned in the bid.**
- The bid should include Transportation Cost with loading and unloading of machinery, Transit Insurance, Oil Cost, and Erection & Commissioning cost specifically stated in the quotation.

Bidders should submit their bid in accordance with the following:

- File Format: PDF files only.
- All files must be free of viruses and not corrupted.

The interested bidders may proceed to submit the bid documents by sending an email to **purchase@ceeindia.org** with the subject line 'Bid for Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Training of MRC Machinery at Ujjain site'.

D. Duration

The duration for supply, installation, training and commissioning of the machines listed in **Annexure 1** shall be within a maximum period of **90 (ninety) days from the date of receipt** of the Work Order / Purchase Order.

E. Bid Validity Period

Quotations shall remain valid for acceptance for a **minimum period of 45 days from the date of bid submission**. Bidders must confirm this validity in the Bidder's Declaration at **Annexure 2**.

F. Payment Terms & Conditions

The payment schedule is as follows:

- CEE shall make an advance payment for supply of machines after receiving a signed copy of the Job Order and the schedule for supply of machines at Ujjain. CEE shall allow a **maximum of 40% of the total contract amount** as the **1st instalment**.
- After commencement of fabrication of machines, pre-inspection of machines and plant, and post-inspection after machines are ready for dispatch, shall be carried out by a CEE representative. The Vendor may submit a request for payment after successful supply of machines at the MRC; CEE shall allow a maximum of 40% of the total contract value as the **2nd instalment**.
- The Vendor may submit a request for payment after successful installation and commissioning of the machines at the MRC; CEE shall allow 17% of the total contract amount as the 3rd instalment. The Vendor shall also submit all bills, GST and taxes as per the PO, and a certification that they will provide operations & maintenance support and up-keep of all machinery for one year.

- The final **3% payment** shall be released at the end of the 1st year, subject to satisfactory performance and receipt of the signed Forms in **Annexure 4**.

H. Liquidated Damages

Failure to comply with the Terms & Conditions of the Purchase Order (PO) will result in payment of liquidated damages equal to **10% of the contract value of the PO, without prejudice to CEE's other rights and remedies**.

I. Penalty Clause

CEE reserves the right to impose a penalty of **10 % up to the total value** of the contract and to withhold all pending payment amounts, in cases of non-completion of the Purchase Order within the agreed timelines. This provision is intended to ensure accountability and adherence to the agreed contractual terms.

J. Evaluation Criteria

As CEE may procure different machines (Lots) from different vendors, each bid will first be evaluated for technical compliance and bidder eligibility against Sections B and C above. Among technically qualified bidders, the lowest all-inclusive quoted price (**L1**) **as per Annexure 3**, will ordinarily be recommended for award of that Lot, subject to CEE's right to reject any or all bids without assigning reasons.

K. Site Visit

Bidders may, at their own cost, visit the MRC site at Ujjain prior to bid submission to assess site conditions, access and available power supply.

L. Power Supply & Civil Works

Incoming electrical power supply up to the designated point at the MRC building, and the civil foundation for the machines, shall be provided by CEE / the Service Provider. The bidder is responsible for all starters, motors, panel boards, and wiring from the designated supply point to each machine, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

M. General Conditions

- **Force Majeure:** Neither party shall be liable for delay or failure to perform its obligations under the contract to the extent such delay or failure results from events beyond its reasonable control, including natural disasters, war, civil unrest or governmental action.
- **Termination:** CEE reserves the right to terminate the contract, in whole or in part, in case of the Vendor's material breach, upon written notice, without prejudice to any accrued rights or remedies.
- **Dispute Resolution & Jurisdiction:** Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this RFQ or the resulting contract shall first be resolved amicably through mutual discussion, failing which it shall be subject to arbitration/the courts having jurisdiction in Ahmadabad, as mutually agreed.
- **Confidentiality:** All information shared as part of this RFQ process is confidential and shall not be disclosed to third parties without prior written consent of CEE.
- CEE is not bound to accept the lowest or any quotation and reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, in whole or in part, without assigning any reason.
